I hope that by now most of you have selected the Reading Program Plan you want to complete for the year, & have started reading!

As we move into Lent, this season in the church calendar would be a great time to read a selection from the Spiritual Growth category of the Reading Program. A few books that might be of interest are 40 Days with Wesley, a 40 day Lenten devotional experience that weaves inspirational readings on faith and prayer with quotes and excerpts from John Wesley. This book is from the 2020 Reading Program list. Also Easter Stories: Classic Tales For the Holy Season. This book, also from 2020, is a collection of short stories that shed light on the deeper meaning of Easter. From 2021-2022, Right Here Right Now: The Practice of Christian Mindfulness reveals the Christian roots of mindfulness and actual practices that deepen the life of faith. Faithful Families: Creating Sacred Moments At Home is a book for this year that offers creative ways to discover & develop new spiritual practices as a family. These are just a few of the books in the Spiritual Growth category.

Also consider listening to the Faith Talks podcasts, these monthly interviews or conversations with UMW mission studies authors explore themes & resources that empower us to put faith, hope, & love into action. These can be found at <u>unitedmethodistwomen.org/faithtalks</u>. If you listen to 3 Faith Talks podcasts it counts as two books in the category Spiritual Growth.

Social Action

Even with the pandemic still seemingly in full force, there is a lot going on in the realm of Social Action with the United Methodist Women. Here are some of the opportunities you might want to take advantage of.

1. South Carolina House Bill H.3747 is more properly called "Female Health and Wellness Act". It is a bill to amend the Code of Laws of South Carolina by adding Chapter 139 to Title 44 so as to define "Feminine Hygiene Products" and to provide that the sale of feminine hygiene products are exempt from sales tax. One of the sponsors of this bill is Greenville's own Chandra Dillard. It is currently in the Ways and Means Committee of which Ms. Dillard is a member. You can write your legislator asking him or her to add his or her name as a sponsor of the bill or just to support the bill. A sample letter is below:

I am a constituent of yours and am writing to you about my support for H 3747 removing the sales tax from feminine hygiene products. This bill is currently in the Ways and Means Committee.

Feminine hygiene products are necessities for women and taxing them is unconstitutional and a form of discrimination. Further, exempting these goods by categorizing them as medical equipment or supplies would greatly benefit low-income groups.

I am asking you to add your name as a sponsor to this important bill and to support it wholeheartedly when it comes to the floor for a vote.
