

sources. As most of the schools, businesses, and other organizations have switched to Zoom for meetings, so has the UMW. What that means for my area and the Reading Program is that all of the information is online. Now, this is not new as the information has always been there, however, our members are urged to visit it more as there seems to be less printed material available during the pandemic. Online, you can find numerous resources that were available in the printed version in a PDF format, which can be downloaded and printed. If you find that you need assistance, please do not hesitate to contact me (acoffee@clemson.edu) and I will assist you with locating the information on the UMW website.

I have just attended the District Officer's Training and the following information is new for the upcoming year (s). First, I would like to congratulate all of the members who participated in the 2019-20 Reading Program! The *Reading Program* reading list is now available for two years, 2020-2022, instead of one year and books in the 2015-2016 reading list fall off of the bookshelf. That means books available for the reading program can come from the 2017-2022 reading list. They are still deciding if certificates will be given annually, as they are currently scheduled for the second year. I will let you know when a decision is made. The new reading list is located online on the UMW website under Mission Resources and in the Response Magazine. The *2021 Annual Sampler* is available for purchase for a discount price of \$40. This includes the Spiritual Growth Study, Prayer Calendar, 2021-22 Program Book, and 2021-24 Quadrennial Calendar. The discount price ends April 2021. If you would like an order form emailed to you, let me know. The complete *2021–2024 UMW Handbook* will be forthcoming after the General Conference 2021, digitally and in print, and will incorporate changes resulting from General Conference decisions. Starting in the summer of 2020 the policies and guidelines are being offered online only until the complete Handbook is published. Mable Clarke and her committee announced the initiation of phase three for their church: To preserve the church and one room schoolhouse forever and to begin a program to assist and support the young students in the community academically. Thanks to all the donors to Soapstone Church and the many prayers on their behalf, God's house is still God's house and doing God's work. (Anderson District UMW had 8 love offerings.) The church extended an invitation to all who would like to do so to come visit for a Sunday service.
