Absentee members were Jessica Jones (excused), Evelyn Neal and Laura Mitchell.

Bridgette Gruber led the devotional with prayer and Biblical references to deal with the COVID -19 pandemic.

Carrie Murray read the minutes which were adopted and received as information.

New Business / Announcement

Killingsworth Virtual Gala will be held November 12, 2020.

Those able to join the Faith Walk with Bishop Holston on Saturday, June 20 are asked to wear your UMW tee-shirt. If you are not able to participate, pray.

Reports were given from the following officers:

- **President** Sandra Love participated in local board meetings, supported mission projects, and conducted a discussion on the District Annual Meeting. The general consensus was to host a virtual meeting in September at which time we would elect officers, extend recognitions and present the Woman of the Year from local units.
- **Vice President** Deborah Schooler announced that SCCUMW would sponsor a Virtual Mission 2020 study on *Finding Peace in an Anxious World* that would be divided into three sessions- July 18th ; July 25th and August 8th. Registration is free. Virtual Mission for youth would be held July 11th and August 1st.
- **Treasurer (acting)** Deborah Schooler reported having received sixteen remittances and would submit a written report.

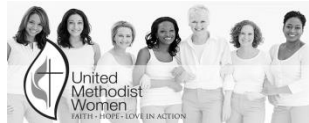
