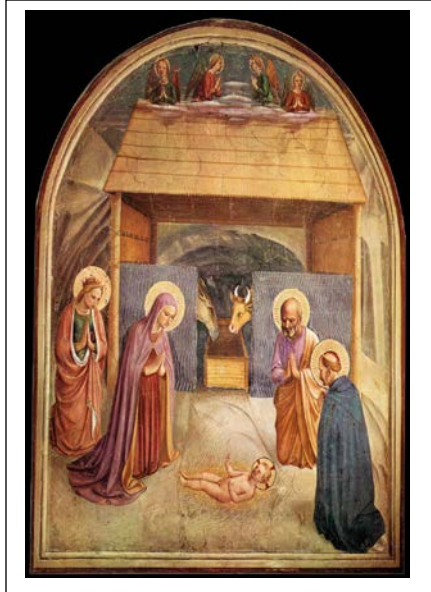

Nominations

We still have seven open positions on the Rock Hill District Executive Board. Nominations -Work with the Nominations Committee to keep board positions filled. Keep up with years of service of all board members.

2 Nominations Reps (Fort Mill/Indian Land Cluster and Rock Hill Cluster) - Develop a relationship with UMW members in your cluster. Provide information to them on upcoming openings on the board. Recruit new board members from your cluster.

2 Cluster Leaders (Chester Cluster and Lancaster/Kershaw Cluster) -Keep an updated list of UMW units in your cluster. Forward Informer via email to unit presidents or other designated people in your cluster. Check with UMW units in your cluster so you can share what is going on to the board. Direct units to appropriate board member when needs arise.
