The 2023 Reading Program catalog is now available to download & print from umwmissionresources.org, as is a blank Reading Program reporting form. Books can be purchased through an online retailer, or from local bookstores. Also, some can be found from public libraries. A list of titles for 2023 that are available through Greenville County Public Library (there are about 23) is included at the end of my report.

There is also a comprehensive list of books from 2018-2023 that can be accessed online, as 2018-2023 are the years that are eligible for reporting credit.

Bonus books continue to count as 2 books except in the Spiritual Growth category. For 2023, one must participate in or lead one of the studies to receive Bonus book Reading Program credit in that category. This is outlined on page 22 of the catalog in more detail.
