SUBEJCT: 2024 FALL LAY SERVANT MINISTRY SCHOOL

The Greenwood District Spring Lay Servant Ministry School is set for September 8 and September 15, 2024. These sessions will be held at Central UMC, 1005 College Street, Newberry S.C. 29108.

We will be offering four courses:

- **Basic-** This course is foundational for all courses in Lay Servant Ministries. Participants are encouraged to discover and employ personal spiritual gifts as God intended and to consider the importance of exercising servant leadership, developing future leaders, remaining rooted in consistent spiritual practices, and being part of a group that holds members accountable in their discipleship. Registration fee is \$35.00.
- Pre requisite for all the advanced courses below: Basic
- **Discover Your Spiritual Gifts-**This course helps participants understand spiritual gifts and how the church can use them to fulfill its mission and ministry. Participants will also learn what it means to be a spiritual leader and will be equipped to lead others in exploring and using their spiritual gifts. Registration fee is \$35.00.

- Aging and Ministry in 21st Century – This course offers a rich learning experience that includes knowing more about the aging process and the developmental stages of midlife and older adulthood and how we can best shape our ministry. Registration fee is \$35.00

Sacraments: Means of Grace - In the new 10-hour advanced course, Sacraments: Means of Grace, Rev. Beth Galbreath crystalizes her unique focus in the online Be A Disciple courses on Baptism and Holy Communion (see page 33), combining her unique approach with the key insights of the late Gayle Carlton Felton in her two books on our sacramental life: By Water and the Spirit and This Holy Mystery. Registration fee is \$35.00

The guidelines in the 2016 Book of Discipline indicate that individuals seeking recognition as Certified Lay Servants or Lay Speakers should take at least one advanced course every three years. If an advanced course is not taken in that time period, then the individual will be required to re-take the Basic Course for continued certification.
