

Conference awarded \$1.1 million grant to develop intergenerational ministry centered on children

For years, churches have sought ways to be more fruitful in ministry with children. Soon, United Methodist churches in South Carolina will have new tools to support this effort, thanks to a grant from the Lilly Endowment. This funding will enable the South Carolina Conference of The United Methodist Church to establish a new ministry in collaboration with Messy Church USA, Narrative 4, and the West Virginia Conference UMC via its Portico online learning system.

Connecting Children in Worship and Prayer will foster a culture of belonging in congregations and promote a shift in how worship is experienced, focusing on intergenerational practices involving storytelling and the arts.
