

Mia, age 13, describes school as having fights every day, smoking in the gym, having the presence of guns, and having four armed police officers present daily. She sees no use to go to school because you can't learn anything anyway.


Shannon, a first grader, refused to write anything, covering up her inability to read, as well as her lack of phonetic awareness. Her teachers felt she would write when she felt ready to.
