

Guide our actions to glorify you, build your kingdom and provide good stewardship of your creation.

Unfortunately, the Predatory Lending legislation did not make it through the process and into law this session. We need to work harder to contact both House and Senate Legislators to communicate the importance of this issue to their constituents. Not enough contacts have been made. To make a contact is simple. Basically, give a message like, "Please support capping the lending interest rate in South Carolina at 36%. This is the same cap that the US has for military families. South Carolina is one of 1-5 states that has no cap. Our most vulnerable families are really being hurt by the exorbitant interest rates they are being charged. We need to change this situation for South Carolina families." Please send an email, letter or perhaps the best is a call, or maybe all three. Included in this newsletter is a list of legislators for our district and their contact information.

Another issue we can all help with is taking care of God's creation. Planting trees is one way we can help. Give them as gifts at birthdays, anniversaries, Christmas, weddings even in lieu of flowers at funerals, Plant one or more trees through the websites: onetreeplanted.org or National Arbor Day Foundation. It costs \$1.00 per tree.

We can also use green products like laundry detergent. One product that is available also eliminates the plastic jugs that detergents are packaged in from our landfills. It comes in sheets and is available from sheetslaundryclub.com or from Publix's Grocery Store. An additional option is Buff City Soap where they will refill the same plastic container (theirs) each time you purchase their detergent. There may be other options that you know about. Please share them.

We recently learned through a conference wide project to raise money by February 14 about a clean drinking water crisis for school children in Jackson, Mississippi. In a zoom event on June 24 at 10:00 a.m. "... learn about water concerns in South Carolina. Guest speaker will be from the South Carolina Law Project. This Workshop is presented by the South Carolina Conference, The Charter for Racial Justice Committee. Participation in this Zoom event, sharing about it. and acting on it will satisfy credit for one of the activities for your unit's Diamond Certificate." (Information comes from Conference Flyer)

There is still time to earn the Diamond Unit Certificate, If you would like ideas, please call me at 864-247-5364. The form to complete and mail to me (104 Terrace Drive, Seneca, S C 29672) is in this newsletter. Please be sure the name of your unit is on the form and the contact person. Your unit must complete 3 activities on the list. It would be wonderful for all the United Women in Faith units in Anderson District to be Diamond Units.

Our District gave an offering of \$235 to the Dickson Memorial U M Church Food Pantry in Townville. The offering was given from the Day Apart event at Mt. Zion United Methodist Church in Central.

It has been meaningful and an honor to serve as the Anderson District Social Action Chair. Thank you






